Oral, Poster & Research Paper Presentation Guidelines and Award Categories



ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- **Presentation Duration: 5 minutes**
- **Discussion & Question Session: 2 minutes**
- **Presentation should be prepared in Microsoft PowerPoint (PPT/PPTX).**
- **Maximum 5-8 slides.**
- **Font size should be readable (minimum 24 pt).**
- **Include graphs, tables, photographs, and illustrations wherever applicable.**
- **The first slide should contain:**
 - **Title of the Paper**
 - **Author(s) Name**
 - **Affiliation**
 - **Email Address**
- **The final slide should include key conclusions and acknowledgements.**
- **Presentations must be delivered in English/Hindi.**
- **Participants are requested to join the online platform 15 minutes before their scheduled session.**
- **Presentation certificates will be issued only to registered presenters.**

- ◆ **Poster Size:** A1 (594 × 841 mm) (Portrait Orientation)

- ◆ **Format:** PDF or High-Resolution Image (300 dpi)

 - Authors and Affiliation●

- ◆ Use **charts, photographs, and figures** for better visualization.

- ◆ Authors will be provided **5 minutes** for poster presentation and interaction with judges.

- ◆ Poster should be **original and unpublished**.

MANUSCRIPT FORMAT

- ✓ Original and unpublished research/review paper.
- ✓ **Language:** English
- ✓ **File Format:** MS Word (.doc/.docx)
- ✓ **Paper Length:** 6–12 pages
- ✓ **Font:** Times New Roman
- ✓ **Font Size:** 12
- ✓ **Line Spacing:** 1.5
- ✓ **Margins:** 1 inch on all sides.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

01

The abstract must be original and should not have been previously published or presented at any other conference.



02

Authors must submit their abstract under one of the following conference themes:



Theme 1: Women in Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security

Theme 2: Women in Livestock, Veterinary Science, and Animal Husbandry

Theme 3: Women in Horticulture and High-Value Crop Production

Theme 4: Women in Fisheries and Aquaculture

03

Authors must clearly indicate the selected conference theme and their preferred mode of presentation (Oral or Poster) at the time of submission.



04

The presenting author must complete the conference registration before the abstract can be considered.



05

Each registered participant may submit a maximum of two abstracts.



06

All abstracts will undergo peer review by the Scientific Committee. Acceptance will be based on originality, scientific quality, relevance to the selected conference theme, clarity of presentation, and overall merit.



07

The Scientific Committee will make the final decision regarding acceptance and the mode of presentation (Oral or Poster).



08

Authors must ensure that all data, results, and information presented are accurate, authentic, and ethically obtained.



09

Plagiarism, duplicate submission, or any form of unethical publication practice will result in immediate rejection of the abstract.



10

The decision of the Scientific Committee shall be final and binding.



IMPORTANT NOTES



An acceptance notification will be sent to the corresponding author after peer review.



Accepted abstracts will be included in the **Conference Abstract Proceedings (e-Abstract Book)**.



Selected full-length papers may be invited for publication in the Conference Proceedings (**ISBN**), Edited Book (**ISBN**), or Partner Journal (subject to peer review and editorial policy).



Certificates will be issued only to registered participants who present their work during the conference.



We warmly invite researchers, academicians, scientists, students, extension professionals, policymakers, entrepreneurs, NGOs, and women farmers from around the world to share their innovative research and contribute to building sustainable and resilient food systems.
